

| <p>Angle of View: 90°</p> <p>View looking west from unclassified road to the east of the site at Bryn Ala.</p> <p>Classification of Receptor: Highway</p> <p>Distance from boundary: 550m</p> <p>Elevation: 60m AOD</p> <p>Sensitivity: Moderate</p> | <p><u>Foreground</u></p> <p>Edge of building and hard standing associated with Bryn Ala property.</p> <p><u>Middle Distance</u></p> <p>Open agricultural land with well established trees forming field boundaries together with hedgerow banks. (cloddiau)</p> <p><u>Far Distance</u></p> <p>Agricultural land on the ridgeline.</p> | <p>DESCRIPTION OF VIEW</p> | <p>The proposed extension lies within the mid ground of this view, however the intervening topography will largely screen the quarry extension from this vantage point. Potential exists to see quarry machinery during the initial soil stripping operation, however this would be seen against the backdrop of the higher land to the west. In the longer term, it may be possible to see a thin sliver of the upper face on the western boundary. This would, however, would be only 2/3 metres in depth and would be barely perceptible, given the distance.</p> | | <p>Once quarrying is complete, the upper benches will be restored by overtipping quarry overburden which will then be left to regenerate naturally. The upper benches on the western face will be subject to early restoration by means of a small restoration blast to soften the edge of the quarry. Once the blast is completed, the face will be greened utilizing retained overburden. Thus, the quarry will be assimilated into the surrounding landscape.</p> | |  | | |
